NO VISA REQUIRED (NVR) ENDORSEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

General information

1. Individual possessing dual citizenship of United States of America and Bangladesh or holding US passport may apply for affixation of “No Visa **Required**” (NVR) for Travel to Bangladesh in their US passport.
2. Child duly endorsed on parent’s Bangladesh passport will be eligible for NVR on his /her US passport. Children not endorsed will also be eligible (In this case, please follow paragraph 5 below).
3. Rules may be changed from time to time.

Application instructions

1. Fill in the prescribed form (page 1) completely in two copies.
2. Submit 2 (two) recent passport size photographs
3. Valid US passport (US passport should be valid for at least 6 (six) months).
4. Submit copy of the Dual Nationality Certificate issued by the Government of Bangladesh or notarized copy of Bangladesh passport even if it is expired (page 1 to 7)
5. If the applicant is a child who was born in the US and not endorsed to a parent’s Bangladesh passport

following documents are required to get NVR on his/her US passport:

- a. Two copies of NVR application forms for each applicant.
 - b. Two copies of recent passport size photographs.
 - c. Notarized copies of their birth certificates showing both parents name.
 - d. Notarized copies (first seven pages) of both parents Bangladesh passport. In case the applicant is a child endorsed in mother’s Bangladesh Passport, attach notarized photocopy of mother’s passport only (page 1 to 7).
 - e. A self addressed prepaid return envelope, preferably USPS Express/certified mail, UPS (except ground) or FedEx (payment by credit card is not acceptable)
 - f. Fee US \$ 50.00 in money -order/cashiers check payable to the Embassy of Bangladesh.
6. If an applicant wants a return mail service, a **self-addressed pre-paid** return envelope, preferably USPS Express/certified mail, UPS or FedEx (**payment by credit card is not acceptable**) should accompany the application.
 7. Application is received at the counter between 10:00 a.m. - 1:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, except holidays. Pick up time from 3:30-5:00 p.m. on working days only.
 8. **Processing time for NVR is 3 (three) business days** provided all requirements are fulfilled.
 9. The NVR Endorsement is valid until the validity of the passport on which it is affixed.

10. To transfer an NVR seal from an expired US passport to a renewed one, one has to apply afresh. The application process will be as follows:

- a) Application fee –US \$ 50.00 in money -order/cashiers check payable to the Embassy of Bangladesh.
- b) Two copies of duly filled in application forms,
- c) two recent passport size photographs,
- d) Expired US passport along with photocopy of its pages containing biographical information and the page containing expired NVR seal,
- e) New US passport.
